An Ordinance to amend the Deposit Schedule for violations of Section 7.210(3) of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating snow removal and deposits.

Section 1. Deposit of Snow or Ice on Streets Prohibited.. If anyone violates Section 7.210, the snow and ice removal ordinance, the standard deposit shall be as follows:
