Subject: Suspended Drivers Licenses/Unregistered Vehicles - Trailer Park on Waldo Blvd.

Good Morning,

Our office received a call from Arthur Kracht (920-662-4595) who lives at 3910 Waldo Blvd. Lot 44 who has an issue with his neighbor (William Vreeke who lives in Lot 46) and the many other drivers in the City of Manitowoc who drive with suspended licenses, have unregistered vehicles, and drive without insurance. As you may know, this is an ongoing neighborly dispute, but the last time Arthur contacted the PD, he said an officer shared with him some statistics about

how many of these kinds of offenders there are in the City of Manitowoc as a whole, and he was shocked by how high those numbers are.

Arthur doesn't understand why the PD can't do anything more with these offenders than issue them a citation. He asked if an ordinance could be drafted to change how offenders of these things could be dealt with. I asked him for a suggestion, and he asked why something can't be put on the steering wheel of the car (similar to what is/was done with drunk driving offenders) until the owner has a valid drivers license back, or until the vehicle is registered in the name of a person with a valid drivers license. He asked if unregistered vehicles could be tagged in some way, and give the owner 30 days to register it.

I told Mr. Kracht that I would share his concerns, questions, and suggestions with the Manitowoc Police Department, and his Alderperson.
