Hi Dan,

The fish grinder repair doesn't fall into the "re-occurring maintenance" category" which is what I am responsible for like winterizing the fish cleaning station, docks, fuel system, launch ramps etc. The fish grinder would fall into the city's portion of the maintenance account which as you know is only budgeted for about 20K for the year. Any cost spilt would/should come out of that account which is why I was hoping that you could find some funding in a different area like perhaps room tax. I hate to dig a hole into the budget when the year has barely just begun and , as you know, we have an aging facility (and furnace and air).

As, I believe you are aware, I already invest substantial money into maintaining the marina.....somewhere in the area of triple the city's annual budget for the marina. Please let me know how you plan on proceeding. I was surprised that they need to send a technician to install? That seems like that might not be necessary and an additional expense.

Hi Dan.

I didn't have any specific idea as to where the funding would come from. I simply realized that it is not in the marina's maintenance budget and to pull from that account would, more than likely, use up 20-25% of the annual budget for maintaining the marina (portion of maintenance that is the city's responsibility. We invest much more annually) and we are not even 1 month into the year. I was wondering if the room tax fund that the city has could be used as this does help promote tourism and "heads on beds". That is the only source I know of, but I am sure there are many more.

Please let me know what I can do to assist.
