Citizen Request: Washington Park Metro Jam Monument

The City of Manitowoc Parks and Recreation Division is requesting PI Committees recommendation for acceptance of a monument donation to Washington Park. The monument would commemorate Tom Chermak and Bob Mittnacht who have organized Metro Jam which has been held at Washington Park for over 40 years. Metro Jam is an annual 2-Day Music Festival bringing national, regional, and local acts to Washington Park free of charge with concession sales going toward local non-profits.


The stone will be approximately 48" wide by 48" tall by 21" deep. The upper 1/3 of the stone would be beveled and the plaque affixed to the beveled area.

Acceptable location would be Northeast of the seating area near the bandshell. The monument would replace a Park Rules sign which would be moved to a new location.
