RE: Request for Flashing Pedestrian Crossing Signs for Alliance Laundry on South 30th St.
(Item 22-0641)

Members of the Public Infrastructure Committee:

Alliance Laundry has requested the City to install Flashing Pedestrian Crossing Signs for their 2 remaining crosswalks by their company on South 30th Street. They paid the entire cost for the existing signs back in 2020. The intent is to use the same agreement as last time.

Alliance will be required to execute the standard contract/agreement document for this request. Once the document is executed the City will order the flashing crosswalk signs and install them.

The current cost estimate from Decker Supply is \$8,328.60 for the materials. There will also be some additional costs (couple hundred dollars) for our electrician, Mark DeZeeuw, to install the signs. The total cost will be invoiced to Alliance Laundry after the work is completed.

We do not have any issues or concerns with the request.

Therefore, we are recommending that the PI Committee and Council approve the request and enter into the agreement with Alliance Laundry.
