Four of the five docks in the Manitowoc Marina have the original wood decking. This project replaces the 30 year old						
decking with new pressure treated wood. The galvanized frames of these docks are in good shape and the floats are in fair shape. Utility pedestals and cleats will be re-used. Coupled with normal maintenance and this new decking, these						
docks will serve the boating community well into the future.

The City continues to invest in the Marina because it is a known tourist amenity to recreational boaters. Maintaining the Marina is in the best interest of both boaters and tax-payers alike. This project extends the useful life of our original investment by 10 - 15 years. The new decking on four docks will affect 160 slips in addition to our re-fueling area. Thirty (30) slips will be permanently designated as Transient Slips.
