- Coordinate WEDC <C programs to assist with local development & worker training

Services to Municipal Partners to Maximize Economic Impact

- Municipal Services Agreement—Coordinate economic effort & pool annual investment with Two Rivers, Manitowoc, Kiel & private investment.
- Regional & State Representation-New Rep, New North, WI Econ. Development Assoc., International Econ. Dev. Corp.
- Community Marketing—Attraction/Expansion Marketing LocateInWisconsin hosted on Progress Lakeshore Website coordinated with NewNorth (18 Counties NE WI), WEDC- Wis Econ Development Corp. Listed properties are marketed across WI, Nationwide and International marketing trips.
- **Revolving Loan Funds-** Marketing Assistance in applicant business plan assistance & application, joint meetings with applicants, coordination with bank, input at IDC/meeting, track changes in CDBG regulations & requirements
- Municipal Committees-IDC/CDA provide economic development input. Additional Committee support as needed.

RETAIN: Needed Workforce

- 1686 Job Openings in Manitowoc County currently
- 58% of employers have unfilled positions
- Population is declining 3% per year through 2040
- 2025 25% of population will be 67

- Rapid Response Team-Coordinated Team to provide immediate assistance to workers impacted by layoff or shutdown
- Manitowoc Job Fairs-Partnership of Progress Lakeshore, LTC,
 Manitowoc Job Center & Dept of Workforce Development
- Workforce Training Programs-Partnership with LTC, UW-Manitowoc to coordinate needed training and connect with grants to assist companies workforce training.
- <u>Business Education Partnership</u>-Proegress Lakeshore & Mishicot High School advisory councils of employers with the school

Finding the Needed Workers

- Spring Job Fair-Manitowoc & Sheboygan in April at Blue Harbor had 488 job Applicants
- Individual company job fairs at Manitowoc Job Center
- **Vride Program-** to provide transportation of workers to the companies, focus on those not working due to lack of transportation.
- Foster Needle Worker Assistance-Held Job fair July 14th assisted workers displaced by Foster Needle & Manitowoc Co earlier layoffs 260 attendees

2016 Expansion Current Projects

- Artist Loft: \$9.4 Million Project now open
- Meijer \$20 Million, 27.5 Acres Expo
 Redevelopment ETA 2017-18
- Start Up Manufacturer-\$6.5 Million Project for equipment and new building in Industrial Park
- Maretti's/Schwarz Deli Two Rivers -Assisted with Two Rivers RLF & TIF to use former bank
- (TIF) Tax Incremental Financing Districts-Ensure maximum impact
