Hello my name is Gina Wagner. My colleague, Nicole Gesch, and I are teachers at McKinley Academy, a charter school for at-risk high school students. This trimester, September through November, we are offering a Healthy Living class for our female students. We have approximately 18 girls enrolled. The course covers various aspects of wellness, including healthy eating and nutrition, physical activity, emotional wellness, healthy relationships and boundaries, environment, and living conscientiously. We are looking for a neutral place that is safe and distraction-free for our students. A neutral area to discuss sensitive topics would help our girls trust us and each other throughout the course. The fieldhouse would be an ideal location for our course. The stigmas and preconceptions of how we think and act in the 'Math classroom' or the 'English classroom' would be stripped away at an off-school location so that our girls can have space to reveal their true selves. The physical space is large enough to accommodate our group and provides the flexibility that a classroom full of desks and chairs cannot. Being situated Inside Lincoln park and in proximity to the zoo would also allow us to include the critical component of wellness, living in harmony with the environment. Studies show incredible academic, social, and emotional benefits for students who have regular time in natural spaces. It is our goal to raise students who can and will be caretakers of their communities and natural spaces. We would be more than happy to provide services to the park in exchange for use of this space. We want our girls to learn to become responsible stewards of community resources and would love to discuss what that would look like. Thank you for your consideration; we look forward to working with you.
