ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to amend Section 11.060 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating Taxicab Vehicle License and Taxicab Driver's Licenses

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 11.060(3)(c) is amended to read as follows:

(c) Insurance. No taxicab vehicle license shall be issued unless and until the applicant shall have filed with the City Clerk a certificate of insurance in a form satisfactory to the City Attorney demonstrating that the owner is carrying liability insurance with limits of at least \$300,000 per occurrence combined single limit bodily injury and property damage issued by a company authorized to do business in the State of Wisconsin. The vehicle owner shall immediately notify the City Clerk should the insurance policy lapse for any reason. Failure to do so will result in automatic and immediate revocation of the license. The certificate of insurance shall also provide that the policy cannot be canceled until at least 20 days' written notice of such cancellation shall have been given by registered mail to the City Clerk. Any such cancellation of the insurance required hereunder shall be grounds for immediate revocation of the taxicab vehicle license.

Section 2. Section 11.060(3)(e) is amended to read as follows:

(e) Issuance. Following completion of all vehicle licensing requirements, the City Clerk shall issue a taxicab vehicle license to the applicant. Any applicant whose taxicab vehicle license application is denied may appeal such denial to the <u>Finance Committee</u>. Public Utilities and <u>Licensing Committee</u>.

Section 3. Section 11.060(5)(f) is amended to read as follows:

(f) Issuance of License. The <u>Police Department</u> City Clerk's office shall issue a picture identification card upon the granting of a taxicab driver's license. Each licensee shall prominently display this identification card on his or her person at all times while employed as a taxicab driver. The licensee shall not permit any other person to use their identification card.

Section 4. Section 11.060(6)(b) is amended to read as follows:

(b) Request for Review. A request for review shall be set for a hearing before the <u>Finance</u> Public Utilities and Licensing Committee and the Committee shall serve the applicant with notice of such hearing at least 10 days prior to the hearing.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
