- WHEREAS, Ully and his handler, Officer Jason Koenig, started as a team for the Manitowoc Police Department in May of 2011; and
- WHEREAS, his duties as a dual purpose K9 included tracking, drug and evidence detection, and handler protection; and
- WHEREAS, Ully was fully funded from the generous donations from our community; and
- WHEREAS, throughout his career he has had numerous successful drug and evidence finds; and

Ully did 44 school sniffs, 153 vehicle sniffs, finding illegal items 89 times, 17 times he found illegal items while searching 27 buildings for drugs, located 141 articles of drug paraphernalia, 721.2 grams of THC, 9.5 grams of Cocaine/Crack, 41.9 grams of Heroin, 34.2 grams of Methamphetamines, and 30 grams of Ecstasy; and
- WHEREAS, Ully has helped seize \$6,989 in U.S. Currency, has located 18 articles of evidence, including 2 guns, one of which was used in a Milwaukee homicide and assisted in getting a conviction in the case; and
