

RESOLUTION

WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY OPERATOR

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Wastewater Treatment Facility has submitted a request to hire a new, additional Operator unbudgeted position, to bring staffing levels back to its status prior to 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Wastewater Treatment Facility Board at a meeting held on March 7th, 2017; the Public Infrastructure Committee on May 8th, 2017, and the Personnel Committee on June 5th, 2017, all approved the hiring of an additional Operator unbudgeted position, to bring staffing levels back to the 2011 levels; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has enacted a resolution requiring 2/3 approval of the Common Council prior to filling a vacancy.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by Mayor Justin M. Nickels and the Common Council of the City of Manitowoc to approve the hiring of an additional Operator, to bring staffing levels back to its status prior to 2012, consistent with the City's Comprehensive Pay Plan within the Employee Policy Manual, and a deviation from the 2017 Mayor's adopted Executive Budget.
