When use of the trail is requested, consideration is given to how the public's use of the trail will be affected. Set up / take down and clean up, as well as other services provided by a City staff may be billed on a cost-recovery basis. The event organizer must provide a copy of event liability insurance naming BOTH CITIES as co-insured at least 10 days prior to the event. Permits do not allow "exclusive use" of the trail and the general public must be allowed to share the permitted areas.

This agreement is made and entered into by and between the Cities of Two Rivers and Manitowoc, Wisconsin, hereinafter called "City" and the above-named individual, hereinafter called "Permittee." The parties agree as follows: Bookings must be made no earlier than 12 months in advance. The Permittee understands his/her responsibility is to set up, clean up and restore premises within the time period listed above.

Limitation of Use: Permittee agrees that the number of persons on the rented premises during the rental period shall not exceed the capacity of the facility and that no intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages shall be served to minors. ### Adriana,

The City of Manitowoc's reconstruction project on South  $10^{th}$  St. runs from Dewey St. to Viebahn St. and as Marc stated is scheduled to start right after the  $4^{th}$  of July. This project is expected to take about 4 months to complete the work.

We also have plans to reconstruct a small portion of Mariners Trail along Memorial Drive from E. Reed Ave. to approx. 400 ft. to the south of E. Reed Ave. We do not know the timing of this project yet. We are first opening bids for the project on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. This is a pretty small project and we are planning to have the trail open on the weekends on either gravel or new asphalt.

### Good Morning Adriana,

I was informed by the City of Manitowoc that south 10<sup>th</sup> St. will be under construction after the Independence Day weekend. With this said, the County plans of resurfacing CTH LS (S. 10<sup>th</sup> south of Viebahn to Carsten's Lake Road) may be scheduled within the same timeframe to limit traffic detour phases. I would suggest to plan on the alternate route proposed earlier this year and simply follow up a few weeks prior to your event to verify if plans have changed. Weather has a major impact on construction schedules and the alternate route may be the best way to plan without conflict.

Manitowoc County: Viebahn to Carsten's Lake Road will be resurfaced.

City of Manitowoc: South 10<sup>th</sup> Street from Viebahn to the north will be under full reconstruction.



I was informed by the City of Manitowoc that south 10<sup>th</sup> St. will be under construction after the Independence Day weekend.
