RESOLUTION

WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY ELECTRICIAN

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Wastewater Treatment Facility has submitted a request to hire a replacement Wastewater Treatment Facility Electrician, with a 4 to 5 month overlap for training purposes, prior to an upcoming retirement on March 30th, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Committee, at a meeting held on October 2nd, 2017, and the Public Infrastructure, at a meeting held on October 11th, 2017, both approved filling this position with an overlap for training purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has enacted a resolution requiring 2/3 approval of the Common Council prior to filling a vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc to approve the hiring of a replacement Wastewater Treatment Facility Electrician, with up to a 6 month overlap from the date of hire, prior to an upcoming retirement on March 30th, 2018, at Grade K, all according to the Compensation Plan and Employee Policy Manual, and to backfill any budgeted vacancies created as a result of this hiring.
