Dear City Clerk,

I am writing to you in regards to the complaint and citation of not removing snow from the sidewalk in a timely manner on the property located at 1511 South 10th Street in Manitowoc. I would like to ask that the citation be withdrawn.

First and foremost, the house is not my primary residence. It is currently a vacant home that I am trying to renovate in my free time and am not there very often; even less in the wintertime. At that time last winter, I was working 2nd shift. I understand snow and ice need to be taken care of in a timely manner, however, with my work schedule, the unpredictability of snow fall/storms and having to clear the sidewalk of my primary residence first, I have not been able to immediately head out to clear the sidewalks of the second property.

There have also been times when I get to the property and find that the sidewalk has already been cleared, most likely by one of my neighbors. While I appreciate the "help", I have never asked for it nor do I appreciate the fact that he has not contacted me to voice his feelings or communicate anything to me before making a complaint. And while I assumed he was doing a "neighborly thing", I have never taken it for granted.

I have always made every effort to get to the property first thing the mornings after snow falls—if it happens during the night, to plow snow off the sidewalks and I will continue to do so. Also, I have since switched to working 3rd shift now so should be able to get out to the property either in the early mornings or evenings to plow snow and clear the sidewalks.

Again, I ask that you please withdraw the citation as it never was or has ever been my intention to leave the sidewalks to my neighbors or the city to plow for me.





SIDEWALK VIOLATION NOTICE

February 3, 2017

Dear Property Owner:

This is to notify you that the City of Manitowoc Department of Public Infrastructure has received a complaint that your property at, parcel #122-000-100 (1511 S 10TH ST) is in violation of City of Manitowoc Ordinance 7.21 (1). This ordinance states that snow and ice must be removed from the full paved width of the sidewalk by the property owners, lessees and occupants.

If snow/ice is not removed from the full paved width of the sidewalks within three (3) days of the date of this notice, the City will clean the sidewalk and costs will be assessed to the abutting property owner. Sand or salt may be used for ice control on sidewalks.

The minimum assessment for snow/ice removal on any city sidewalk in a three year period shall be assessed as follows: 1st violation-\$300, 2nd violation-\$600, 3rd and subsequent violations-\$900. For any work longer than 60 minutes per violation, there will be an additional charge for labor and equipment (over and above the violation fee).

You will not receive any future violation notices. Your sidewalk will be cleaned and assessed per occurance if not in compliance with Manitowoc City Ordinance and resolutions.

Your cooperation with cleaning your sidewalk is greatly appreciated.
