Participation Agreement with Anthem Blue Cross Blue Shield - Well Priority Plan Health and Dental Insurance and National Vision Administrators (NVA) Vision Insurance for 2018

WHEREAS, the City of Manitowoc's benefits broker for employees' health and dental insurance has recommended renewing with Anthem Blue Cross Blue Shield, self-insured Well Priority Plan, and moving from VSP to National Vision Administrators (NVA) vision insurance, which vision plan is completely funded by employees, for 2018; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on October 2nd, 2017, the Personnel Committee recommended approval to remain with the Well Priority Plan, the current dental benefit plan package, and moving from VSP to National Vision Administrators (NVA), which vision plan is completely funded by employees, for 2018; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City's administration of the employees' health and dental insurance to select the Well Priority Plan, and to select National Vision Administrators (NVA) vision insurance, which vision plan is completely funded by employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc to approve the attached summary of the Health, Dental and Vision plan administration and plan design for 2018.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Human Resources Director and Finance Director/Treasurer be authorized to enter into all necessary agreements to implement the insurance, and to submit a monthly report to the Common Council on agreements entered into.
