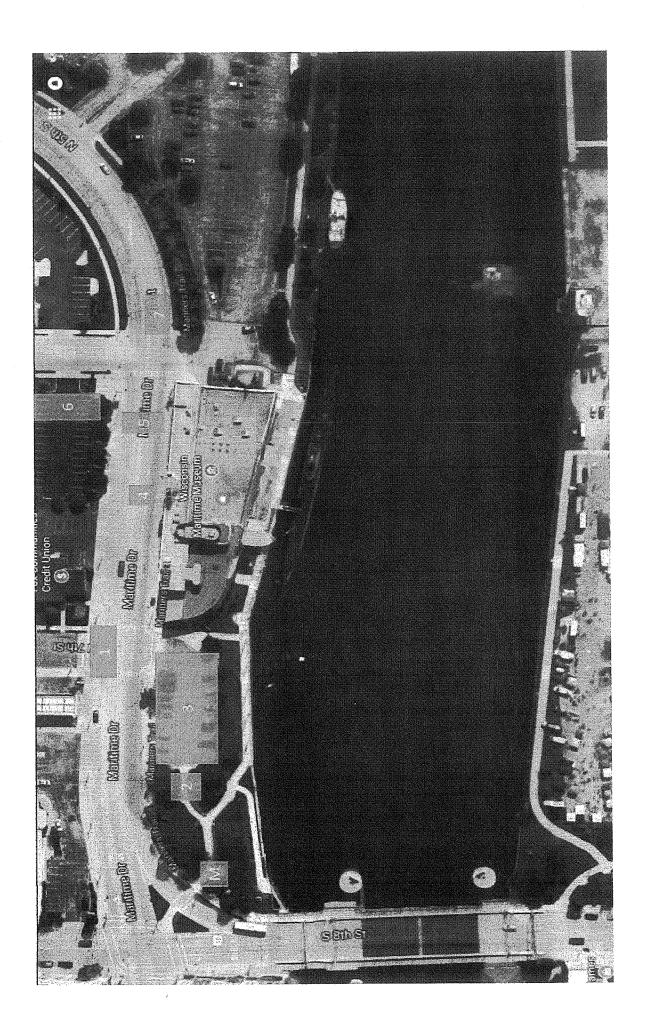

Dear Parks division,

I am helping prepare for Subfest and we are looking at getting some larger tents this year to cover certain areas. To go larger, they would need to be staked into the ground. The one tent that is beyond the size of a stake-less tent would be located in the Shipbuilders Park parking lot. 2 of the 4 sides look like they can go into soil, but the north and east side would need to go into cement or blacktop.
