Elizabeth,

Per our phone conversation, I did review the crash data in the area of Calumet Ave in the City of Manitowoc between S. 36th St. and S. 35th St. The crash data was reviewed from 2013 to the available preliminary 2018 crash data or approximately the last 5.5 years. I removed all crashes that law enforcement coded as intersection crashes and focused on non-intersection crashes between S. 36th and S. 35th.

During this time period, I found the following crashes related to the McDonalds driveway:

- *1 Suspected serious injury crash involving a motorcyclist. Driver was leaving the driveway and pulled in front of a SB US 151 motorcyclist

- *10 property damage only crashes

- o3 of 10 drivers pulled out of the driveway and was struck by a SB US 151 driver

- o2 of 10 drivers pulled out of the driveway and was struck by a NB US 151 driver

- o3 of 10 drivers were traveling SB US 151 turning right into McDonalds driveway involving rear-ends

- o1 of the 10 was traveling NB USH 151 waiting to turn left into McDonalds driveway and was rear-ended

- o1 of the 10 was the last of a group of motorcyclists exiting McDonalds and was rear-ended by a NB US 151 driver
