

## **ORDINANCE**

An Ordinance to amend Section 10.390 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating Parking

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 10.390 is amended to read as follows:

## "10.390 Parking Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to park such vehicle in any of the places where parking is prohibited by Wis. Stat. Ch. 346, except to comply with the directions of a traffic officer or traffic control signal or sign, or to park upon any portion of the following designated streets or places:

...

Green Street. There shall be no parking on Green Street as follows:

- (a) On the north side of Green Street from the east curbline of South 10th Street for a distance of 68 feet to the east. No parking from no parking sign to corner.
- (b) On the south side of Green Street from South 9th Street to South 10th Street, during school hours.

Hamilton. Between the hours of 7:30 a.m., and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, there shall be no parking on Hamilton Street between South 9<sup>th</sup> Street and South 10<sup>th</sup> Street except for school buses for the purpose of loading and unloading, beginning at the west curbline of South 9<sup>th</sup> Street for a distance of 160 feet west.

Harbor Town Lane. There shall be no parking on both sides of Harbor Town Lane from South 41st Street to Dewey Street.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
