both firefighters attempted to assist with a self-rescue of the female in

distress;

WHEREAS, both Firefighter/Paramedics found that the female was unable to perform a

self-rescue and began to go beneath the surface of the water causing

greater concern of the situation escalating; and

WHEREAS, Firefighter/Paramedic Valleskey entered the Manitowoc River in order to

provide a rescue of the female; and

WHEREAS, the female was safely removed from the River and provided care by Manitowoc Fire Rescue Department EMS Services.
