#### Greg,

The existing light on Rapids Road is functioning normally. Spacing of existing fixtures is adequate per ANSI standard RP-8. The following options are recommended if the city would like an additional light:

- A. Add a non-ornamental, 250 Watt "Cobra Head" light may be added to the existing utility pole on the north-west corner. No installation cost. Monthly cost is about \$14 (\$171 per year) to street light invoice.
- B. Add an ornamental, 100 Watt "Coach Light" on the north side of Remiker Lane, about 165' east of the existing coach light. Installation cost is about \$2,000. Monthly cost is about \$11 (\$133 per year).
