## To Whom It May Concern:

On 01-03-2019 at 0827 hours I, Officer Dramm, investigated an accident in the intersection of S. 10<sup>TH</sup> Street and Franklin Street. Essentially, a City of Manitowoc plow truck was S.B. in the left had (East side) curb edge with the front plow. As the snow plow driver heads S.B. he sees a legally parked pickup truck adjacent to the Manitowoc Fire Department and realizes he will be driving around the pickup and not plowing the curb edge. As the driver is about to enter the intersection he lowered his side wing plow (right side of the snow plow) and hit a passing automobile prior to beginning to change lanes.

I would recommend that there be "NO PARKING" in the area adjacent to the Manitowoc Fire Department Station #1 on the east side of S.10<sup>th</sup> Street. The accident would not have happened had there not been a vehicle parked adjacent to the Manitowoc Fire Department. The S. 10<sup>th</sup> and Franklin Street intersection is a main intersection in the City of Manitowoc that consistently is the scene of traffic accidents. In the interest of the public safety it would be best to eliminate parking on the east side of the street due to the volume of traffic in the above mentioned intersection.
