There is no charge for a trail permit, and events will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Considerations for permitting a trail event include type of event, day of event, and other requests within 30 days of the event, as well as other considerations that may affect the public's use of the trail.

All special events or activities approved by the permit panel (Two Rivers & Manitowoc Park & Recreation Directors) can be reserved 12 months in advance including a renewal, "First Right of Refusal" clause. Set up, clean up and take down and other services provided by a City staff will be billed at the hourly rate currently charged by the Park & Recreation Department. Event promoter must provide a copy of liability insurance naming both cities as co-insured at least 10 days prior to the event. The Permittee understands his/her responsibility is to set up, clean up and restore premises within the time period listed above. Permittee is required to provide event liability insurance naming the Cities of Two Rivers and Manitowoc as co-insured.
Limitation of Use: Permittee agrees that the number of persons on the rented premises during the rental period shall not exceed the capacity of the facility and that no intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages shall be served to minors. Permittee agrees to use premises rented for the purpose stated above and no other. In the event this Limitation of Use is not complied with, Permittee shall be charged and agrees to pay a fee of \$200.
