

Amount Remitted WisDOT staff have been working to unlock more potential in our financial systems since moving to PeopleSoft in 2016. The goal has always been to be as transparent as possible and provide you with needed financial information. We are continuing to work on providing the level of detail that our customers expect.

LDO charges update

In November 2018, you should have seen a change in your invoices. *Labor-Delivery-Other (LDO)* charges are now distributed proportionately across project cost categories. Previous billings were based on estimates, requiring additional charging or credit reconciliation at project completion. Our invoices now reflect actual, real-time costs as the project progresses. The current practice of including LDO with the appropriate activity allows for billing and payment as the work is expensed.

Local LET Contract Reimbursement (Work Credits) update

We have been able to determine a solution to simplify the work credit process for calendar year 2019 project costs. Local governments will continue to send the department a bill for the full project amount, but for 2019 projects, WisDOT is able to simply reimburse the locals for the federal cost share.

We are continuing to work with our developers to improve the invoicing process and will provide updates as changes are made.
