Dan Koski explained that all are drivers begin at part time and move to full time. Alder Jacobs questioned how the City recoups its money if the employee quits right away? Lillibridge stated that this has not happened to date. Jacobs suggested trying to give a monthly amount for a year instead of all at once beginning employment.
