ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to amend Section 10.490 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating Two Hour Parking.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 10.490 is amended to read as follows:

**"10.490 Two-Hour Parking.**

...

**North 9th Street.**

~~(a) On the west side of North 9th Street from Maritime Drive to York Street~~

(a) On both sides of North 9th Street from York to Chicago Street.

(b) On the west side of North 9th Street from Chicago Street to Buffalo Street.

...


~~York Street. On both sides of York Street from North 7th Street to North 10th Street except on the north side of York Street between the west curbline of North 8th Street and a point 110 feet west-~~ (a) On the north side of York Street from North 7<sup>th</sup> Street to 115 feet west of N. 10<sup>th</sup> Street.

(b) On the south side of York Street from North 7<sup>th</sup> Street to North 8<sup>th</sup> Street.

(c) On the south side of York Street from North 9<sup>th</sup> Street to 115 feet west of N. 9<sup>th</sup> Street."

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication, and shall be in effect until September 1, 2019.
