(c) Minimum Operating Requirements.

- 1. New Licenses. An establishment applying for a license for the first time under this section must comply with the general licensing procedure in subsection (2)(d) of this section. Any application for a license shall go before the Common Council within 180 days of the application being filed with the Clerk.
- 2. Renewals. An establishment renewing a license issued under this section agrees to be open a minimum of 60 days each year for at least four hours per day. Failure to maintain these operational requirements will be grounds for nonrenewal or revocation of license. Businesses shall be responsible for maintaining a log of their operating hours. All renewals are also subject to an inspection by the City.
- 3. Catastrophic Exception. A business that cannot comply with the requirements to open due to a catastrophe or natural disaster may petition the Council for waiver of the licensing requirements for the remainder of the business year to allow the business time to rebuild. Council may grant one additional year's extension, as circumstances allow.
- 4. Revocations. If a license granted under this section is revoked, the licensee will not be entitled to a refund of any portion of their license fee. Licensees who are revoked may not apply for a new license for 365 days from the date of revocation.
