This particular meeting was a culmination of pervious efforts to address the overgrown vegetation ditch line along Orchard Lane. The ditch vegetation restricts the ability of surface storm water to freely flow eastward, which backs up and floods our field. We currently lease our property to Joe Holsbach for agricultural purposes, the enclosed photos reflects the flooding of the agricultural property after the last rain storm. Lack of maintenance along the Orchard Lane may result complete crop loss on this parcel, this drainage issue has previously been discussed without a cure.

The ramifications of water backing up and over our field banks is not acceptable, what are your plans to address this maintenance issue.
