Proposed Recovery of Reinspection Costs for

Enforcement of Minimum Property Maintenance Standards

Reinspection

- Follow-up inspection conducted on a date specified by the enforcement officer or inspector
- Verifies that an ordered remedial action has been taken and that the non-compliance or violation no longer exists
- Scheduled to allow the property owner a reasonably sufficient time to correct any noted non-compliance or violation

Reinspection Fee

 Any fee charged for an inspection other than the initial inspection when required work has not or was not completed and results in additional trips to the site by the enforcement officer or inspector

Purpose

 To recover costs incurred by enforcement officials and inspectors who spend considerable time investigating, inspecting and reinspecting properties throughout the City of Manitowoc in an effort to ensure compliance with the municipal code or applicable state codes

Intent

- A reinspection fee is an appropriate method to recover costs incurred for investigation and additional inspections made by enforcement officials and inspectors
- If the property owner fails to comply by the date specified in the courtesy notice sent to them informing them of existing violations on their property and a date for compliance
- The assessment and collection of reinspection fees shall not preclude the imposition of any administrative or judicial penalties or fines for violations of the municipal code or applicable state codes



It is estimated that issues requiring a reinspection account for approximately 75% of total site aspections. And of those required reinspections it is estimated that 75% will be non-compliant.
