BUILDING/HVAC/FIRE ALARM/FIRE SUPPRESSION AND PLUMBING


WHEREAS, the City of Manitowoc (City) has long collected fees for various services, rentals, inspections and programs in order to defray some of the costs associated with providing same; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue being able to provide these services to the public in order to meet the City's building and inspection needs; and,

WHEREAS, the Professional Services Agreement between the City and EPLEX (DBA as E-Plan Exam) was approved by the Common Council on December 18, 2023 which requires adoption of the fee schedules set forth in the attached Commercial Plan Review Fee Schedule-Building/HVAC/Fire Alarm/Fire Suppression and Commercial Plan Review Fee Schedule-Plumbing.
