

RESOLUTION

POLICE CHIEF JOHN MUSIAL

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2025, the Police and Fire Commission of the City of Manitowoc appointed Assistant Police Chief John Musial to the position of Police Chief for the City of Manitowoc upon the retirement of Police Chief Nick Reimer on March 20, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that the recommendation of the Police and Fire Commission to appoint Assistant Police Chief John Musial as Police Chief for the City of Manitowoc is hereby approved, effective March 21, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc, that Police Chief John Musial is placed at Grade S, as a full-time exempt position with a rate of \$125,080.00 in the City of Manitowoc Compensation Plan. Paid Time Off accruals shall remain unchanged in accordance with the Employee Policy Manual.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Police Chief is authorized to fill any additional sworn officer vacancies that result from filling the Police Chief position in accordance with the Compensation Plan, the Mayor’s Executive Budget, and the Labor Agreement with the Manitowoc Professional Police Association.
