RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER WITH MANITOWOC COUNTY FOR CTY TRK HWY "R" (A/K/A NORTH RAPIDS ROAD) IN THE CITY OF MANITOWOC (Waldo Boulevard to Broadway Street)

WHEREAS, the Common Council has been provided with a map that shows a 0.80 mile portion of CTH "R" (N. Rapids Rd.) from Waldo Boulevard to Broadway Street identified as number 2 and shown as a green line on said map ("Subject Roadway"); and

WHEREAS, while the Subject Roadway is part of the County Trunk Highway system, it is located in the City of Manitowoc ("City"); and

WHEREAS, in the future the driving lanes on the Subject Roadway will be replaced in concrete ("Driving Lane Replacement Project"); and

WHEREAS, Manitowoc County agrees to pay one-half of the cost to replace the driving lanes on the Subject Roadway in concrete; and

WHEREAS, the City will sponsor and pay for the engineering portion and management of

the Driving Lane Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, the City and Manitowoc County have determined that it is in the public interest to transfer jurisdiction and maintenance of the Subject Roadway to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed in principle to accept the transfer of the Subject Roadway; and

WHEREAS, the City will take over all maintenance and access and utility permitting of the Subject Roadway on October 1, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Common Council members authorize the jurisdictional transfer to the City that 0.80 mile portion of County Trunk Highway "R" (a/k/a North Rapids Road) located from Waldo Boulevard to Broadway Street; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Common Council of the City of

Manitowoc authorize such City of Manitowoc officials as necessary to enter into a Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement with Manitowoc County transferring that that 0.80 mile portion of County Trunk Highway "R" (a/k/a North Rapids Road) located from Waldo Boulevard to Broadway Street.


