RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Municipal Code 12.150(1)(a) provides that the installation of nonornamental lighting systems for public street, parks or boulevards which is deemed necessary or desirable for the safety of pedestrian and vehicular traffic shall be ordered by the Common Council by the granting of petitions signed by owners of property abutting on the street or boulevard where lighting is desired or by resolution adopted by the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code 12.150(1)(b) provides that the installation costs for nonornamental lighting shall be borne by the Manitowoc Public Utilities; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code 12.150(1)(c) provides that the operation, lamp renewal and maintenance expenses of the City's non-ornamental lighting shall be paid from the City's general fund on a month-to-month basis upon receipt of a bill from the Manitowoc Public Utilities. The rates for such service shall be those approved and on file with the Wisconsin Public Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, City of Manitowoc Engineering Department and Manitowoc Public Utilities deems it desirable for removal of 3 non-ornamental lights at 1000 block of South 10th Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common council of the City of Manitowoc, that Manitowoc Public Utilities is ordered to remove three (3) each total, non-ornamental, 125 Watt, LED Cobra style, street lights at 1000 block of South 10th Street.
