The Board of Review will meet on the 15th day of May, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. at Manitowoc City Hall in Council Chambers for the purpose of calling the Board of Review into session during the 45-day period beginning on the 4th Monday of April, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 70.47(1).

Oue to the fact the assessment roll is not completed at this time, the Board of Review will be adjourned until a later date and will meet at Manitowoc City Hall in Council Chambers.

Please be advised of the following requirements to appear before the Board of Review and procedural requirements if appearing before the Board of Review.

- After the first meeting of the Board of Roview and before the Board of Roview's final adjournment, no person who is scheduled to appear before the Board of Review may contact or provide information to a member of the Board of Review about the person's objection, except at a session of the Board of Review. Doep book shall occur no toss than 7 days prior to the Board of Review.
- than 7 days prior to the Beard of Review.

  2. The Beard of Review may not hear an objection to the amount or valuation of property unless, at least 48 heurs before the Beard of Review's first scheduled meeting, the objector provides to the Beard of Review Clerk written or crainctice of an intent to fite an objection, except that upon a showing of good cause and the submission of a written objection, the Beard of Review shall waive that requirement during the first 2 hours of the Beard of Review's first scheduled meeting, and the Beard of Review and the Beard of Review may waive that requirement up to the end of the final day of the session if the session is less than 5 days, with proof of extraordinary circumstances for faiture to meet the 48-hour notice requirement and faiture to appear before the Beard of Review during the first 2 hours of the first scheduled meeting.

  3. Objections to the amount or valuation of property shall first be made in writing and filed with the Board of Review Clork within the first 2 hours of the Board of Review Within the first 2 hours of the Board of Review may waive that requirement up to the end of the first scheduled moreling, except that, upon evidence of extraordinary droumstunces, the Board of Review may waive that requirement up to the end of the final day of the session, or up to the end of the final day of the session if the sossion is less than 5 days. The Board of Review may require objections to the amount or valuation of property to be submitted on forms approved by the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, and the Board of Review shall require that any forms include stated valuations of the property in question. - 4. When appearing before the Board of Review, the objecting person shall specify in writing the person's estimate of the value of the land and of the improvements that are the subject of the person's objection and specify the information used to arrive at that
- estimate.

  5. No person may appear before the Board of Review, testify to the Board of Review by telephone, or object to a valuation if that valuation was made by the assessor or the objector using the income method of valuation, unless no later than 7 days before the first meeting of the Board of Review, the person supplies the assessor with all the information about income and expenses that the assessor requests, as specified in the Assessor's Manual under Wis. Stat. § 73.03(20). The City of Manitowes has an ordinance for the confidentiality of information about income and expenses that is provided to the assessor under this paragraph that prevides exceptions for porsons using information in the discharge of dubes imposed by law or the dubes of their officer or by order of a court. The information that is provided in this paragraph, unless a court determines that it is inaccurate, is not subject to the right of inspection and copying under Wis. Stat. § 19.35(1).
- 6. The Beard of Review shall hear upon oath, by telephone, all ill or disabled persons who present to the board a letter

from a physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice nurse prescriber certified under Wis. Stat. § 441.16(2) that confirms their illness or disability. No other persons may testify by telephone unless the Board of Review, in its discretion, has determined to grant a property owners or their representative's request to testify under oath by telephone or written statement.

7. No person may appear before the Board of Review, testify to the Board of Review by telephone, or contest the amount of any assessment unless, at least 48 hours before the first meeting of the Board of Review, or at least 48 hours before the objection is heard if the objection is allowed under Wis. Stat. § 70.47(3)(a), that person provides notice to the Board of Review Clork as to whether the person will ask for the removal of a member of the Board of Review and, if so, which member, and provides a reasonable estimate of the length of time the hearing will take.

8. No person shall be allowed to appear before the board of review, to testify to the board by telephone or to contest the amount of any assessment of real or personal property if the person has robused a rossonable written request by certified mail of the assessor to enter onto property to conduct an exterior view of the real or personal property being assessed.
