Police Chief Nick Reimer and Engineering Division Manager Greg Minikel reviewed the request and suggested a 4-way stop at the intersection of South 33rd Street and Dale Street would be beneficial, given the nearby schools that utilize this intersection. However, they do not recommend the installation of rapid flashing beacons or lighted signs at Redfin Court. Instead, they recommend implementing ladder pavement markings.

A motion was made to draft an ordinance for a 4-way stop at the intersection of South 33rd and Dale Street. Additionally, paint ladder crosswalks in all directions at the South 33rd and Dale Street intersection, paint a ladder crosswalk at Redfin Court at Dale Street, install no parking signs within 15 feet of a crosswalk on the west side of South 33rd Street north of Dale Street, and direct Chief Reimer to contact the bus company about bus parking.
