

**ORDINANCE**

An Ordinance to amend Section 8.230 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code to adopt the provisions of Wisconsin Statute § 125.06(6).

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 8.230 is amended to read as follows:

**“8.230 Regulations of Parks and Related Facilities.**

(1) Alcohol Beverages.

(a) Pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 125.06(6), fermented malt beverages may be sold by city officers or employees in any city park under such terms and conditions as authorized by the Director of Parks and Recreation or his designee.

~~(a)~~ No person shall possess or consume alcoholic beverages, wine or fermented malt beverages in Washington Park, Union Park, Riverview Park, Pulaski Park, Lincolnshire Park, Schuette’s Park, Custerdale Playground, Union Park Playground, Mariner’s Landing, Manitowoc Youth Baseball Complex at Citizen Park, or Municipal Athletic Field, except where provided pursuant to subsection (1)(a), above, and except where the person has obtained possession of fermented malt beverages from the holder of a Class “B” license authorizing the sale of such beverages at such park. This prohibition shall extend to the sidewalks in and immediately adjacent to the parks listed above, except that it shall not be a violation of this section if any person possesses wine or alcoholic beverages on such sidewalks in the original unopened containers.

~~(b)~~ No person shall possess or consume any alcoholic beverages, wine or fermented malt beverages on the sidewalks surrounding the parks named in subsection (1)~~(a)~~ of this section except where provided pursuant to subsection (1)(a), above, and except that it shall not be a violation of this section if a person possesses the beverages on the sidewalks in their original unopened containers or if a person has obtained permission from the Special Events Committee/Common Council to possess alcoholic beverages in the above-named parks.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
