

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS,** City of Manitowoc deems it desirable to install an ornamental lighting system to illuminate the River Point Development; and,

**WHEREAS,** Municipal Code 12.150(2)(a) defines ornamental street lighting as a type of lamp that is mounted to a standard or post to which energy is supplied from an underground electrical distribution system or from fixtures of special ornamental design; and,

**WHEREAS,** Municipal Code 12.150(2)(b) provides that the Common Council may order installation of ornamental street lighting upon receipt of a petition by 50 percent or more of the owners of the taxable frontage of any street, or may by resolution provide for the installation of an ornamental lighting system without any such petition; and,

**WHEREAS,** Municipal Code 12.150(2)(c) provides that the installation cost may be paid by the property owners or by the City at its discretion; and,

**WHEREAS,** the installation cost for illuminating the roadway is estimated at \$107,218.66, as provided in Manitowoc Public Utilities construction cost estimate for this portion of the River Point Development; and,

**WHEREAS,** Municipal Code 12.150(2)(d) provides that the operation and maintenance expenses of the ornamental street lighting system are to be paid from the City’s general fund to the Manitowoc Public Utilities according to rates approved and on file with the Wisconsin Public Service Commission; and,

**WHEREAS,** Manitowoc Public Utilities recommends installing ten (10) each, 40-Watt, Double-Acorn, ornamental, LED street lighting standards to provide lighting consistent with ANSI RP-8, American National Standard Practice for Roadway Lighting.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc, that Manitowoc Public Utilities install and maintain ten (10) each, 40-Watt, Double Acorn, ornamental LED street light standards in the River Point Development.
