

**RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER WITH
MANITOWOC COUNTY FOR CTY TRK HWY “CL” (A/K/A VIEBAHN STREET) IN
THE CITY OF MANITOWOC AND THE TOWN OF NEWTON
(Hecker Road to S. 26th Street)**

WHEREAS, the Common Council has been provided with a map that shows a 1.50 mile portion of CTH “CL” (Viebahn Street) from Hecker Road to South 26th Street identified as number 7 & number 8 and shown as a green and yellow line, respectively on said map (“Subject Roadway”); and

WHEREAS, while the Subject Roadway is part of the County Trunk Highway system, it is located in the City of Manitowoc (“City”) and the town of Newton (“town”); and

WHEREAS, Manitowoc County has scheduled an asphalt overlay project for 2028 on the portion of the Subject Roadway from South 26th Street to I-43, which the County will fund and perform; and

WHEREAS, the City has scheduled a construction project for 2025 on the portion of the Subject Roadway from I-43 to Hecker Road, which the City will fund; and

WHEREAS, the City, Manitowoc County and the town have determined that it is in the public interest to transfer jurisdiction and maintenance of the Subject Roadway to the City and town; and

WHEREAS, the town accepted the transfer of an approximately 0.25 mile section of the Subject Roadway in its jurisdiction on December 28, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the town has agreed to pay the City annually for its portion of General Transportation Aids for the section of the Subject Roadway in its jurisdiction in exchange for the City agreeing to perform all maintenance and access and utility permitting on the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed in principle to accept the transfer of the other

approximately 1.25 miles of the Subject Roadway that lies within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City will take over all maintenance and access and utility permitting in the 1.25 mile section of the Subject Roadway transferred to it on October 1, 2024.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Common Council members of the City of Manitowoc authorize the jurisdictional transfer to the City that 1.25 mile portion of County Trunk Highway “CL” (a/k/a Viebahn Street) that lies within the City’s jurisdiction from Hecker Road and S. 26th Street; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc authorize such City of Manitowoc officials as necessary to enter into a Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement with Manitowoc County transferring that 1.25 mile portion of County Trunk Highway “CL” (a/k/a Viebahn Street) that lies within the City’s jurisdiction from Hecker Road and S. 26th Street.

Fiscal Impact:

At the time, indeterminate of exact dollar amount of fiscal impact. Anticipated additional revenue to be received in General Transportation Aids from State due to additional road miles being the responsibility of the City. Known expenses that will increase due to the additional road miles being the responsibility of the City are but not limited to: labor/equipment: snow plowing, grass cutting, grading of gravel; materials/supplies: salt/brine for winter maintenance, latex/epoxy paint/service for maintenance of markings; general maintenance expenses associated with roads as time lapses since new construction. It is anticipated expenses will be more than revenue received; however, it is of the opinion of the Finance Director that having the above named section of road under the ownership of the City is in the best interest of the City for control, task management, and consistency.

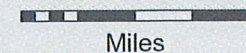
