TO AUTHORIZE APPLICATION FOR INFLATION REDUCTION ACT (IRA) URBAN FORESTRY GRANT

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Infrastructure of the City of Manitowoc is designated as the "Authorized Representative" for purposes of the grant application, and is hereby authorized and empowered by the City of Manitowoc to sign and submit an application to the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for any financial aid that may be available, and sign a grant agreement between the City and the Department of Natural Resources, and submit interim and/or final reports to the DNR to satisfy the grant agreement, and submit grant reimbursement request to the DNR, and sign and submit other required documentation.
