

**RESOLUTION TO
DISSOLVE SPECIAL EVENTS COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Committee, at a meeting held on May 28, 2026, recommended revisions to the City of Manitowoc Special Event Policy; and

WHEREAS, the Manitowoc Common Council has established various boards, committees, and commissions to assist the Council and Mayor in conducting City business; and

WHEREAS, the Special Events Committee was created in 2015 by the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, following the adoption of the revised Special Event Policy the Special Events Committee is no longer needed or useful; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Committee, at a meeting held on May 28, 2026, recommended dissolving the Special Events Committee, effective immediately; and

WHEREAS, the revisions to the Special Event Policy require the Parks and Recreation Department to make informed decisions about proposed special events; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department will need to be informed of major street work and closures in order to make recommendations and provide information to applicants for special events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc to dissolve the Special Events Committee, effective immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that the Department of Public Works is directed to annually provide, by January 15 of each year, a list of the capital projects that have been budgeted for the forthcoming year.
