
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PROJECT INTRODUCTION










Context

- The Henry Schuette Park
 Playground sits in a unique
 location in Upper Henry Schuette
 Park:
 - Connects two neighborhoods
- Located at an Ice Age Trail trailhead
- Along the railway corridor











Site


- This community-built playground is approximately 20 years old:
- 19,000 sq.ft.
- Loose rubber chip surface
- Treated lumber structure
- Sits on sloping grades
- Includes restroom structure
- Rich, community involved history






Site Visit

- Traffic experience confirmed our findings in the inventory and analysis phase of the project. Traffic calming and wayfinding must be used in tandem to provide safe access to the park.
- Current amenities are 'park-like' and do not adhere the vision indicated by the Core Team.

This process guides every decision that the design team makes moving forward, to make sure we stay in alignment with the project leadership and the priorities of the community.




Visioning Session

 A visioning session took place on February 17 to gain identify themes and community wants to help inform the Vision Statement and Values that guide the project





<u>Connected:</u> create physical, community, regional, and environmental connections.










Q1 What best describes your connection to the City of Manitowoc?





























Q8 What activities do you typically engage in when visiting Henry Schuette Park? (select all that apply)




























Master Planning: Bike/Ped


Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan calls Schuette Park Playground as a destination, and it is connected though on-street paths in the short and medium-

term projects










Master Planning: Trails

Add physical traffic calming measures and narrow the main intersection. Add flashing DOT signage and speed limit signs to Broadway St.








Precedents

Preliminary Program

Natural:

- -Nature-based 2-5 age playground
- -Nature-based 5-12 age playground
- -Flexible adult adventure playground
- -Educational interpretive signs on nature walking paths

Connected:

- -Complete trail system
- -Connect to Lower Schuette
- -A community gathering place
- -Flexible outdoor game space

Invested:

- -Year-round restroom
- -Rentable spaces
- -Drinking fountain
- -Bike amenities
- -Connections to neighborhoods and trails

Ideals:

- -Enclosure for playgrounds
- -Traffic Safety
- -ADA parking stalls + safe parking lot
- -Safe routes to access the park
