Police Chief Reimer stated that in the past year, the Police Department has received an increase in scam reports linked to cryptocurrency kiosks within the City. This prompted discussions with the City Attorney about the possibility of regulating these kiosks to enhance community protection.

Attorney Nycz explained this is an new area of concern and that Wisconsin has been slow to address this issue. Attorney Nycz identified three different approaches to address the issue.

- 1. Warning/Caution signage
- 2. Moratorium on new machines
- 3. Ban the machines within the city limits

The recommendation at this time is to adopt the attached ordinance to warn users of the fraud connected to these machines.
