Hi Chad,

Here is the email I sent back to Amber.

You were also inquiring about the cost for flashing stop signs for northbound and southbound traffic on South 14<sup>th</sup> St. at Division St.

As far as flashing stop signs, I would estimate that each stop sign would be in the range of \$2,000 - \$2,500.

The cost 10 years ago was \$1,345 plus some DPW costs for installation.

If we go this route, I can get a cost from our supplier. Thanks.

Amber,

This probably makes sense.

I would recommend that if approved the RRFB Crosswalk light/sign would be located on the south side of Division St. as this pedestrian crossing is at 90 degrees. The north side pedestrian crossing is more like a 45 degree angle.

I do not have any updated costs. The one we did at Maritime and Huron St. in 2024 was about \$6,500. Therefore, I would estimate the cost to be around \$7,500. I could try to reach out to our supplier, but I am not sure if I would get a price before next Monday.

Good Afternoon Alderman Beeman-

I am the principal of Jefferson Elementary School and I have met with my district safety coordinator, Nermana Turajilic about our students crossing at 14th and Division as well as 14th and Manila. We currently have a city crossing guard at 14th and Division, but no one at 14th and Manila. We have a number of students that walk to school and recently have had an influx of parent complaints about cars speeding through/ not stopping for students crossing the street at 14th and Manila. Our ask is would it be possible to a flashing crosswalk sign installed at 14th and Division street for the students walking to Lincoln, Washington and Jefferson. Our district buildings and grounds coordinator Mike Schwarz has agreed to pay for half of the cost.

Secondly our thought is the city crossing guard could then move on 14th and Manila for the number of students crossing there as our students enter our playground from Manila St. I would love to come to a city council meeting to speak about this request and answer any questions. Thank you so much for your time.
