WHEREAS, WOMT Radio first began broadcasting in 1926 and has proudly served the residents of Manitowoc and the Lakeshore Community for 100 years; and

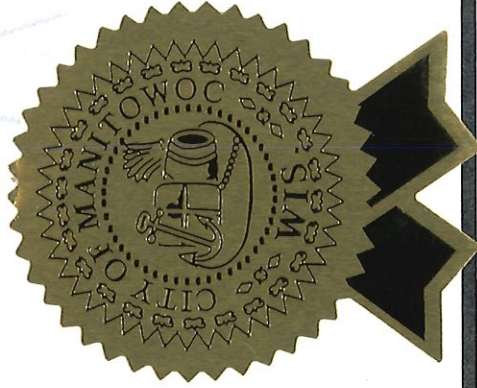
WHEREAS, throughout its century of operation, WOMT Radio has been a trusted and reliable source of local news, information, and entertainment for generations of listeners; and
