I drove the area of South 22nd and Summit St. and printed out some photos.

We very recently installed a stop sign at S. 21st and Summit St. due to the Popp Subd. building Summit St. to S. 21st St.

In that case we stopped traffic on Summit St. (east and west bound).

Using our new Policy:

1. Population Density: No high-occupancy housing in the area, but close to Dewey St. (1 block away)
2. Land Use: see 1 – No Truck traffic allowed.
3. Length of Continued Uncontrolled Travel: S. 22nd St. from Dewey St. to Flambeau St. is 2 long (600 ft to 800 ft. long blocks (total length is about 1,500 feet). Summit St. is the only intersection between the two streets.
4. Presence of Schools, Parks, etc. - Washington Middle School is at S. 21st and Division. Rubick Field and Steinbecker Field is at S. 23rd and Grand Ave. Emma Radandt Park is at S. 22nd and Flambeau St.
5. Traffic Volumes – **HELP** Also – the standards for accidents is not met???? Traffic volume is low (likely less than 1,000 vehicles per day).
6. Crash History – Standards for accidents is not met???? **Need last 3 year crash data from PD.**
7. Speed Limits and Operating Speeds – Limit is 25mph. **Police** – is this an area where you see speeding???
8. City Maintenance and Operations – N/A
9. Street Width – 36 feet for both.
10. Sight Distance and Visibility – Existing Sight Obstruction on the southwest corner (tall arborvitae trees).
11. Pedestrian and Bicycle Activity – Unknown. But there are sidewalks!

For the current request at S. 22nd and Summit it should be noted that the arborvitae trees on the southwest corner of the intersection are impacting the sight distance and visibility. It appears that they are located outside of the 15 foot vision triangle but they still present a vision problem.

Can someone at PD get the past 3 years of accident data. I was not aware of the supposedly several accidents or the roll over.

I would be supportive of installing a stop sign on S. 22nd St. for northbound and southbound traffic.

If the others support this stop sign, then we need to get this put on the Public Safety Committee agenda, correct??
