TREE/SHRUB VISION TRIANGLE VIOLATION NOTICE

February 26, 2024

CHARNETTA GADLING-COLE 635 N 8TH ST MANITOWOC WI 54220

Dear Property Owner:

An inspection of your property at 635 N 8TH ST (parcel # 000059050) has shown that a shrub(s) located on your private property are creating a public nuisance by encroaching on the public right of way thereby creating a hazardous environment. The following clearances must be met:

A vision clearance area must be maintained in accordance with Manitowoc Municipal Code 15.030. Vision clearance means a triangular space at the street corner of a corner lot, or at the intersection of a public alley or public or private driveway with a street, unoccupied, from three feet to ten feet above grade at the right-of-way line, except as otherwise specifically authorized. Such space shall be determined by measuring from the point of intersection of the street lines along each street lot line, or street lot line and alley line, as the case may be, the distance required for the district in which the lot is located, forming a triangle by striking an imaginary line between said points of measurements.

In other words, no shrub, hedge, or other vegetation shall be between 3' and 10' above grade at the property line if within fifteen (15) feet along property lines at any intersection involving public streets, alleys, and public or private driveways. The intent of this provision is to maintain a visual open area in a triangle formed by two 15' sides which would run parallel to such streets, alleys or driveways.

- Clearance above sidewalk must be at least ten (10) feet.
- Shrubs must not protrude onto the sidewalk or alleyway from your property. Shrubs must be trimmed back to the edge of the sidewalk or to the edge of the pavement in an alleyway.
- Clearance above street or alley at curb line or edge of pavement must be at least fourteen (14) feet.

The City of Manitowoc Municipal Code 8.19(7) states that "In the case of an emergency defined herein as a situation which creates an immediate danger or harm to the health, safety or welfare of the public, the City Forester may enter private property to abate a public nuisance without compliance with the notice requirement detailed in this section. If the City Forester shall abate the nuisance on private property, the cost of the abatement shall be reported to the Municipal Tree Commission as a proposed assessment against the property."

We would appreciate your assistance by trimming the affected shrubs as requested within 30 days of the date of this notice. If the shrubs are not trimmed within 30 days, the City of Manitowoc Forestry Division or a private contractor will

complete the work. The entire cost of abating any hazard or public nuisance, including equipment costs, staff time and/or contractor fees, will then be assessed against your property.
