As you may know we just finished our Christmas season and Kettle Campaign. Our goal was \$150,000 but we only raised \$100,520.67. We are still collecting donations online at www.samanitowoc.org, in person or by mail. All the money raised stays here in Manitowoc County and goes back to help families in need.

It is my joy to share some good news with you.

The good news is that, in 2024, The Salvation Army of Manitowoc County was able to provide 7,765 grocery orders, provided 11,639 toys to over 1,088 children and served over 8,527 individuals with rent, energy assistance, clothing, and so much more. 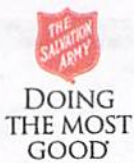

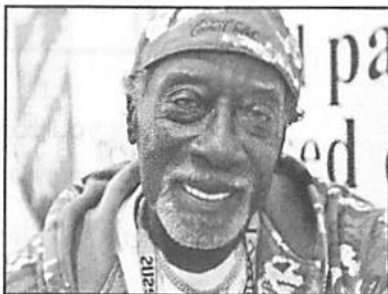
