I believed or thought that the intent was to have this request go to CAWG or Finance to begin the Unbudgeted Request process. Although, I guess it could also go to the Finance Comm. for inclusion in the 2024 budget. I believe the Committee kind of touched on or talked about both options and I am not sure if it was completely clear which way to go.

I believe that the Mayor already has 3 other RRFB's in the proposed 2024 budget at an estimated cost of \$22,500, so are we going to add a 4<sup>th</sup> and bump up the request to \$30,500??

We may want to revise it or wait until we get the quote from Decker Supply (for now I put in \$8,000 which is probably high). I requested a quote from them this morning.

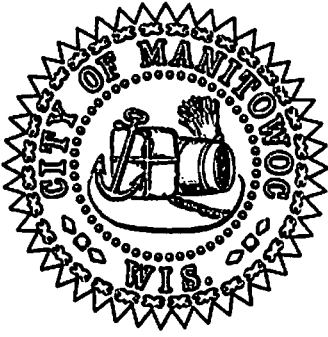

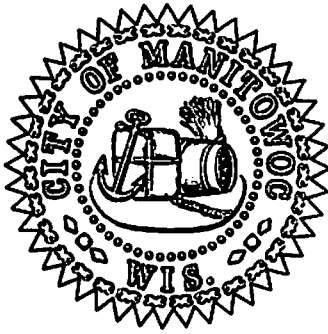

I am assigned to LHS this year and have noticed a city safety concern. I am super worried about all the kids who are trying to cross 10th st and simply run out into the street. This has come to my attention because I have a student who is wheelchair bound and has increased difficulty crossing 10th street to get to school. No one stops and she has to have her parents come with her and to try to help stop traffic. Because of this I have paid special attention and have noticed MANY students crossing and getting half way, and then traffic comes from the other direction and has to stop rapidly.

I feel like there should be some consideration to installing a light that would alert traffic to stop. It could be Columbus or Division?

I am astounded by the poor driving skills that I see. Although, they are all inexperienced drivers.

I thought maybe you could bring it to the city as a concern if you think this is worthwhile. I do not live in this section of the city.
