## **ORDINANCE**

An Ordinance to amend Section 10.390 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating Parking Prohibited.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

**Section 1**. Section 10.390(2) is amended to read as follows:

## "10.390 Parking Prohibited

. . .

(2) Schools. In addition to the parking requirements of Wis. Stat. § 346.52(2), during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on school days, no persons may stop or leave any vehicle standing or parked, whether temporarily or otherwise, upon a designated portion of the near side of any street in front of any school used for children below the ninth grade. The area to which this prohibition shall apply shall be determined by the Chief of Police. Signs shall be placed at each end of the area covered hereunder.

A student drop-off and pickup zone shall be in full force and effect on the west side of South 9th Street from Madison Street to Green Street between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. while Lincoln High School is in session (school days). Drivers may not leave their vehicles during drop-off or pickup."

**Section 2**. Section 10.390 is amended to read as follows:

## "10.390 Parking Prohibited

**South 9th Street.** There shall be no parking on South 9th Street as follows:

. . .

(g) On the west side of South 9th Street from Madison Street to Green Street between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. while Lincoln High School is in session (school days), except for the purpose of student drop-off or pickup, as noted in subsection (2), above.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
