

**RESOLUTION APPROVING A
REVISED PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT POLICY**

WHEREAS, the City of Manitowoc is committed to provide a safe and productive work environment for all employees, including following recommendations from CVMIC, our liability carrier, and OSHA 29 VFR 1910.132 “Personal Protective Equipment Standard”, and incorporated by reference in DSPS 332.15, Public Employee Safety and Health; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on October 7, 2024, the Personnel Committee recommended approval of the request to revise the City’s current Personal Protective Equipment Policy.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by Mayor Justin M. Nickels and the Common Council of the City of Manitowoc to approve the attached revised Personal Protective Equipment Policy to ensure the continuous operation of City government and the safety of its workforce.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc, to direct Human Resources to revise the Personal Protective Equipment Policy as attached, effective immediately, to notify employees of the changes, and to have copies of the updated policy available on the Intranet.
