

ORDINANCE

An Ordinance amending Section 7.010 and 7.020 of the Municipal Code regulating Street Names and Numbers.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 7.010 is amended to include the following:

"The street located in the SW ¼ of Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 24 East, City of Manitowoc and beginning at the intersection with S. 21st Street thence westerly 2,100 feet more or less to its terminus be renamed from Clay Pit Road to Chiefs Way, all according to the attached map."

Section 2. Section 7.020 is amended to include the following:

(7) Street Numbering along Chiefs Way will begin with the number 1 commencing at a starting point being approximately 1,000 feet West of S. 21st Street.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on the date of Common Council adoption.

<u>Section 4.</u> The City Attorney is authorized to make all appropriate revisions to the Municipal Code as a result of this name change.
